How to play Snakes and Ladders:

You will need:

- Print and laminate the A4 Snakes and Ladders board game.
- A counter (or bottle top) for each player.
- A dice. (You can make one out of cardboard if you need to.)

How to play:

- 1. Four people can fit around a small A4 snakes and ladders board. This game can be played in pairs or threes too.
- 2. Players take it in turns to roll the dice.
- 3. The player with the highest number goes first, the person with the second highest goes second and so on.
- 4. The player moves the counter the number of spaces shown on the dice.
- 5. The player reads the word on which her counter lands. Then the group reads the word together.
- 6. If a player lands on a snake's head, the player's counter slides down to the square at the snake's tail.
- 7. If a player lands on the bottom of a ladder, the player's counter climbs up to the square at the top of the ladder.
- 8. The first player to reach the finish is the winner!

You can change the game according to the ability of the players. For example: When playing the game for the second time, learners may be asked to

- read the word aloud.
- make a short sentence with the word.
